Judge Dimock, born in Elizabeth, NJ, graduated from Yale University and Harvard Law School. Before his appointment as a judge, he was in private practice from 1914 to 1941. He also served as editor of the Official Law Reports, lectured at Yale Law School, and served as chairman of the appeals board in the Office of Contract Settlement in Washington DC.

Judge Dimock was nominated by Harry S. Truman as United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on June 11, 1951. He became a senior judge on July 28, 1961, and remained in service until his death on March 17, 1986.

Future S.D.N.Y. Judge Miriam Goldman Cedarbaum served as his law clerk.
