

Judge Feinberg was appointed United States Circuit Judge for the Second Circuit on March 7, 1966 and entered on duty March 18, 1966. He received an A.B. degree from Columbia College in 1940 and an LL.B. degree from Columbia Law School in 1946 when he was editor in chief of the law review.

Judge Feinberg served as a judge of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York from March 17, 1962 to March 7, 1966. He was a member of the Advisory Committee on Civil Rules of the Judicial Conference from 1965 to 1970, and a member of the Subcommittee on Supporting Personnel, Committee on Court Administration, from 1969 to 1971. Since January 1971, he has been a member of the Subcommittee on Judicial Statistics, Committee on Court Administration. He was Deputy Superintendent of the New York State Banking Department in 1958. He served in the United States Army from 1942 to 1945.

Judge Feinberg was a member of the New York City Bar Association, American Bar Association, New York County Lawyers Association, American Judicature Society, and the American Law Institute. He was also a member of the Advisory Council for Appellate Justice.

Future S.D.N.Y. Judge Gerard E. Lynch and Magistrate Judge Michael Dolinger were law clerks to Judge Feinberg.
