

Judge Frankel was appointed United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on October 21, 1965 and entered on duty November 17, 1965. He received an A.B. degree from Queens College in 1943 and an LL.B. degree from Columbia University School of Law in 1948.

Judge Frankel was an assistant to the Solicitor General of the United States from 1952 to 1956, and an attorney for the Department of Justice and the National Labor Relations Board from 1949 to 1952. He was a professor at the Columbia University School of Law from 1962 to 1965, and an associate and a partner in the firm of Proskauer Rose Goetz and Mendelsohn from 1956 to 1962. He has been a member of the board of the Federal Judicial Center since 1972. Judge Frankel served in the United States Army from 1942 to 1946.

Judge Frankel was a member of the New York State Bar Association, American Bar Association, and the Association of the Bar of the City of New York.
