

Richard J. Holwell was appointed to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York on September 22, 2003 and entered service on November 4, 2003. He received a B.A. degree from Villanova University in 1967 and a J.D. degree cum laude from Columbia University School of Law in 1970. He was awarded a Columbia-Cambridge Fellowship in Criminology and received a Diploma in Criminology from Cambridge University in 1971.
