

Judge MacMahon was appointed United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on September 10, 1959 and entered on duty September 22, 1959. He received an A.B. degree in 1936 and an LL.B. degree in 1938 from Cornell University.

Judge MacMahon has served on the Judicial Conference Committee on the Administration of the Criminal Law since 1970 and the Committee on Court Facilities and Design since 1971. He was United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York in 1955, and Chief Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York 1953-55. He was associated with John E. Sullivan, Esq., Elmira, N.Y., 1938-42, the firm of Franchot, Runals, Niagara Falls, N.Y., 1942, the firm of Donovan, Leisure, Newton, Lumbard & Irvine, New York City, 1942-53; a partner in the firm of Kramer, Marx, Greenlee, Backus & MacMahon, New York City, 1955-57; and a single practitioner, New York City, 1957-59. He was a lieutenant, j.g., in the United States Naval Reserve from 1944-45.

Judge MacMahon was a member of the American Bar Association, American Trial Lawyers Association, American Judicature Society, Federal Bar Council, Westchester County Bar Association, Maritime Law Association of the United States and the Cornell Law Association.

Judge MacMahon served as Chief Judge of the District Court from 1980 to 1982. His former law clerks included S.D.N.Y. Judge Paul A. Crotty, Magistrate Judges Henry Pitman and Douglas F. Eaton and former United States Attorney (and Mayor) Rudy Giuliani.
