Judge Martin was appointed United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on April 6, 1990 and entered on duty on May 22, 1990. He received a B.A. degree from Manhattan College in 1957 and an LL.B. from Columbia Law School in 1961. He served as a law clerk to the Honorable Leonard P. Moore of the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit from 1961 to 1962 and as an Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York from 1962 to 1966. During his tenure in the United States Attorney's office, he served as Chief Appellate Attorney from 1964 to 1966. He was a partner in the firm of Johnson Hekker & Martin in Nyack, New York, from 1966-1967. In 1967, he became an Assistant to the Solicitor General of the United States and served in that office until 1969 when he returned to private practice as a sole practitioner in New York City. From 1972 to 1979 he was a partner in Martin, Obermaier & Morvillo, and from 1979 to 1980, he was a partner with Schulte Roth & Zabl.

Judge Martin served as United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York from 1980 to 1983.

He is a fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers and the American Bar Foundation and a member of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York.
