Judge Metzner was appointed United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on September 18, 1959. He took Senior status on September 30, 1977. He received an A.B. degree from Columbia University in 1931 and an LL.B. degree from Columbia School of Law in 1933.

Judge Metzner was a member of the firm Chapman, Walsh and O'Connell, New York City, from 1954 to 1959. He was executive assistant to the Attorney General of the United States from 1953 to 1954, and law clerk to New York State Supreme Court Justice William C. Hecht from 1942 to 1945. He was a member of the Law Revision Commission of the State of New York in 1959. He was chairman of the United States Judicial Conference Committee on the Administration of the Magistrates System 1969-1981.

Judge Metzner was a member of the board of trustees of Columbia University 1972-1984, and was a trustee emeritus. He was chairman of the Columbia College Council from 1965 to 1966, and was the recipient of a Columbia University Alumni Medal in 1966.

Judge Metzner was a member of the American Law Institute, the American Bar Association, Federal Bar Association, and was a director of the New York County Lawyers Association from 1957 to 1959.
