Judge Pauley was appointed as a United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on October 22, 1998 and entered on duty on October 28, 1998.

Judge Pauley graduated from Duke University with an A.B. degree magna cum laude in 1974 and received a J.D. degree from Duke University School of Law in 1977.

Following graduation from law school, Judge Pauley served as a Deputy County Attorney in the Appeals Bureau of the Nassau County Attorney's Office. Thereafter, he entered private practice with a mid-town Manhattan law firm. From 1985 until his investiture, Judge Pauley was a founding partner of a litigation boutique where his practice focused on complex federal civil litigation. From 1984 until his appointment to the bench, Judge Pauley also served as Assistant Counsel to the New York State Assembly Minority.
