Edgardo Ramos was appointed United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on December 5, 2011 and entered on duty on December 15, 2011. Born in Ponce, Puerto Rico, Judge Ramos graduated from Yale College in 1982 and received a J.D. from Harvard Law School in 1987.

From 1987 to 1992, Judge Ramos was an associate at the law firm of Simpson Thacher & Bartlett, where he was involved in all aspects of complex commercial disputes. In 1992, he joined the Office of the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of New York. He received the Director's Award for Superior Performance as an Assistant United States Attorney in 1999.

Judge Ramos joined the law firm that would ultimately become Day Pitney LLP in June 2002 as a partner in the White Collar and Internal Investigations Group. In 2003, he was appointed by New York City Mayor Michael Bloomberg to serve on the Commission to Combat Police Corruption. From 1991 until his appointment as a District Court Judge, he was a member of the Board of Directors of Aspira of New York, Inc.

Judge Ramos has served on the governing boards of the Hispanic National Bar Association, the Connecticut Hispanic Bar Association and the Puerto Rican Bar Association of New York City. He has also served on the Criminal Law and Municipal Affairs Committees of the New York City Bar Association. In 2008, Judge Ramos was elected as a James W. Cooper Fellow of the Connecticut Bar Foundation.
