

Judge Stewart was appointed United States District Judge for the Southern District of New York on June 30, 1972 and entered on duty October 6, 1972. He was a graduate of Harvard College, receiving a B.A. degree in 1938, and Harvard Law School, receiving an LL.B. degree in 1948. He practiced law at the firm Dewey, Ballantine, Bushby, Palmer & Wood, where he worked closely with future Justice John Marshall Harlan II.

Judge Stewart served as a Captain in the U.S. Army under General George S. Patton's tank corps in World War II. He was awarded the Bronze Star.

Judge Stewart was a member of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York, New York State Bar Association, the American Bar Association, and the Federal Bar Association of New York and New Jersey.
