Anna Sofia Sjoblom being duly sworn says: that she was a passenger on board the steamship Titanic on a voyage from Southampton to New York, and was on board the steamship when it was in collision on the 14th and 15th of April, 1912, and sank in the Atlantic Ocean between Southampton and New York; that affiant at the time of the collision was asleep in her berth, but was eventually awakened and went on deck when she learned that the vessel was in a sinking condition, she became very much frightened and very nervous, and was shoved about in the crowd and over prostrate people for a considerable length of time, and finally picked up by some one and thrown into one of the last life boats to leave the Titanic; that as the life boat was lowered one of the crew of said steamship Titanic jumped from the upper deck into the life boat landing on affiant's head striking her with his boots, and as a result she lost consciousness, and has ever since suffered and still suffers great pain in her head and in her spine; that affiant was very meagerly clad at said time and became wet with the cold salt water and contracted a very severe cold; that affiant was made very nervous and made sick; that affiant has since said time been under the constant care of a physician, and has not recovered, but is yet in a state of nervous collapse and prostration by reason thereof; that affiant is entirely unable to perform labor.

That affiant lost all of her personal belongings, which were

of the reasonable value of two hundred dollars (\$200.00).

That the amount of affiant's claim for her personal injuries is six thousand dollars (\$6000.00) and the amount of her claim for her belongings lost at said time is two hundred dollars (\$200.00) making a total of six thousand two hundred dollars (\$6200.00); and further affiant sayeth not.
